



#### **NIFT Eligibility criteria**

Age Criteria - Candidate should be 23 years as on 1st October, 2019. Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/ Person with Disability (PWD) categories get five years of relaxation. Students should have passed 10+2 exam from any recognized Central/ State Board of Secondary Examination, such as Central Board of Secondary Education / State Board New Delhi, and Council for Indian School of Certificate Examination, New Delhi. Students should have cleared Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by the National Open School with a minimum of five subjects. Students should hold 3 or 4-years diploma in any branch of Engineering recognized by AICTE or a State Board of Technical Education OR A pass grade in the Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by the National Open School with a minimum of five subjects with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics.

#### **Application Process**

The application form of NIFT 2020 can be filled now from October 23 to December 31, 2019. Candidates can fill application form with late fee till January 4, 2020. The application fee for NIFT 2020 can be paid through online payment gateway or through bank demand draft issued in favour of "NIFT HO" payable at New Delhi. The fee for General/OBC (Non-Creamy) Category-Rs. 2000 through payment gateway or demand draft. The fee for SC/ST/PHP Category-Rs.1000 through payment gateway or Demand Draft. #### THE EXAMINATION PROCESS (for all programmes)

All eligible candidates would have to go through an examination process. The process for each programme is separately listed below:

**B.Des** -For candidates to the UG Design programmes, the selection process comprises a written examination comprising of a Creative Ability Test (CAT) and General Ability Test (GAT), followed by a situation test to be undertaken by shortlisted candidates of the written examination.

**B.FTech** -For candidates to the UG Fashion Technology programme, the selection process comprises a written examination comprising of a General Ability Test (GAT).

**M.Des**- For candidates to the PG Design programme, the selection process comprises a written examination comprising of a Creative Ability Test (CAT) and General Ability Test (GAT) followed by Group Discussion and Personal Interview (GD/PI) for shortlisted candidates of the written examination.

**M.F.M.**- For the M.F.M programme, the selection process comprises of Written test comprising of a General Ability Test (GAT) followed by Group Discussion and Personal Interview (GD/PI) for shortlisted candidates of the written examination.

**M.FTech** - For the M.F.M programme, the selection process comprises of Written test comprising of a General Ability Test (GAT) followed by Group Discussion and Personal Interview (GD/PI) for shortlisted candidates of the written examination.

On the basis of result of written test GAT and CAT, shortlisted B.Des candidates will be called for second test called Situation Test. For B.F.Tech.candidates, GAT will be the final test for selection. The candidates for M.Des will take GAT and CAT. On the basis of the result of GAT and CAT, in the case of M.Des. and GAT in the case of M.F.Tech and MFM, candidates will be called for Group Discussion/Personal Interview(GD/PI).

ommon Entrance Exam for Design (CEED) 2020 will be held by the Indian Institute of Bombay on January 18 for admissions to the masters in Design programmes offered at IIT Bombay, Delhi, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Kanpur, and IISc Bangalore as well as IIITDM Jabalpur. In addition CEED scores are accepted by Anant National University, Lovely Professional University (LPU), Srishti Institute of Art, Design and Technology, University of Petroleum and Energy Studies (UPES), Vellore Institute of Technology (VIT) University and World University of Design (WUD). CEED 2020 consists of two papers with Part A of the exam consisting of Aptitude and Maths being a computer-based test while Part B consisting of drawing being a pen and paper based one. CEED 2019 will be held in 24 cities.

In 2020, CEED was conducted in 21 cities across the country and a total of 6,423 candidates registered while 5,507 candidates actually appeared for the exam. Of these, 1,003 candidates qualified in the exam.

#### **JEE MAINS 2020**

JEE Main is conducted for engineering (Paper 1 – B.E./B.Tech.) and architecture (Paper 2 – B.Arch./ B.Planning) streams. NTA will conduct JEE Main from 2020 onwards. The national level exam will be conducted twice a year (January and April) in online (computer based) mode. Candidates can appear in either of the two or both. Earlier, the exam was conducted by CBSE.

#### **JEE Main Eligibility**

Even though the regulating body has changed, the eligibility criteria for JEE Mains 2020 will remain the same. The standards will vary as per the program opted. A brief about the same is as follows



#### **NATA 2019**

NATA is the national level undergraduate exam which is conducted by Council of Architecture (COA). National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) is conducted for admission to 5-year B.Arch programmes offered by all recognized institutes in the country. Through NATA 2019, eligible candidates can also get admissions into B.Arch programmes offered by Government, Government-aided, Private Unaided, University Departments and Deemed Universities of the country. NATA 2019 will consist of one question paper which will be divided into 2 parts- Part A which will be conducted in online mode carrying Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) from mathematics and general aptitude and Part B in drawing which will be held in offline mode where candidates will be given a A4 sized drawing sheet to answer the questions. Candidates who will be applying for NATA 2019 must refer and meet the eligibility criteria as prescribed by the authorities.

Application forms for NATA will be online and available tentatively from January with the admit card released in April. The exam will be held in the last week of April while the results will be announced online tentatively in June, 2019.

#### **ACT Eligibility Criteria 2018**

There are no specific ACT 2018 eligibility criteria mentioned by the exam conducting authority; the ACT Test 2018 can be attempted by people of all ages and grade levels.

- However, students need to meet the ACT 2018 requirements set by individual institutions/colleges/universities that they are applying to.
- ACT 2018 is a college admission test which is usually taken by high school graduates and those

above the age of 13 years.

• Candidates can take the ACT test 2018 a maximum of 12 times.

The ACT is offered only on Saturdays except for those with credible religious obligations, who may take the test on another day. The ACT test 2018 is conducted on seven national and five international test dates every year.

#### **ACT Test Centers 2018**

Close to two million students from more than 130 countries appear for the ACT 2018 test annually, making it the most popular admission test for college admission in the US. With ACT test centers spread across all major cities, prospective test takers can select an ACT test center as per their convenience. Candidates can choose the ACT test center at the time of the registration of ACT 2018 test.

#### **How to select the ACT Test Centre 2018?**

In order to select the test center of ACT 2018, aspirants should-

- Select their country and state.
- Pick test centers of ACT test 2018 from the dropdown list
- Candidates can narrow down the search even further by typing part or full name of the city.
- There is an option to narrow down the search by entering city or test as well.

#### **ACT Scores 2018**

The composite score of ACT 2018 is ranged between 1-36. The ACT test 2018 result (without writing) is usually available at the end of the second week from the test date, while the result for ACT 2018 with writing (optional) takes two more weeks to get evaluated. Also, students opting for ACT test 2018 with writing cannot send their ACT scores (without writing), unless the scores of writing test have been added. It is because ACT reports scores only for entire test dates. ACT scores are sent to the student, his or her high school, and up to four colleges of the student's choice (optional).

**CAE:** Cambridge English: Advanced (CAE) is another English-language test which is accepted as a proof of English language ability. This test is accepted by 100% universities in UK.

The test dates are available throughout the year. There are 2800 test centers in 130 countries. The exam is both paper-based and computer based.

**CPE:** Cambridge English: Proficient (CPE) is another of the English language tests which are accepted by all the universities in UK. This is conducted in both pen-paper mode and online mode.

The exam dates for this test are generally available every two months and the exam is conducted at over 2800 centers in 130 countries around the world.

### The International English Language Testing System



Is a test taken by people who intend to study or work in a country where English is the language of communication.

IELTS is available in two versions - Academic and General Training. Academic IELTS is for those who apply for higher education or professional registration. General Training is for those who migrate to Australia, Canada and the UK or apply for secondary education, training programs, and work experience in an English-speaking environment. IELTS score is accepted by more than 10,000 institutes and training organizations across the world.

IELTS Test Pattern 2018- The two major bodies responsible for formulating and designing the IELTS 2018 test pattern are Educational Testing Service (ETS) and British Council. British Council, IDP: IELTS Australia and Cambridge English Language Assessment conduct the IELTS 2018 test to measure a candidate's proficiency level in English language. The Test Pattern of IELTS 2018 is designed to reflect the daily life use of English in different walk of life; at study, at work, at play, and at social gathering. Having said that, there are two versions of the IELTS test, namely IELTS Academic and IELTS General Training and the results are graded on the unique IELTS 9-band scale for both the formats. In accordance with the IELTS test pattern 2018, both IELTS Academic and IELTS General Training are composed of four sections namely, Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking. While each candidate is required to take the same Listening and speaking modules in both the versions of the IELTS exam pattern 2018, it is the Reading and Writing modules that alters for the two versions - IELTS Academic and IELTS General Training. The total duration for the IELTS test is 2 hours 45 minutes. Listening, Reading and Writing tests are scheduled together while speaking test may either be taken on the same day or within seven days before or after the IELTS test of Listening, Reading and Writing modules.

According to the test pattern of IELTS 2018, the speaking test is conducted as a one-on-one test to assess a candidate's English communication skills. The candidates are put through a real-life conversation with a real person (not necessarily a native speaker) to get their English conversation skills tested. The responses are recorded by the examiner and later evaluated by the certified IELTS examiners.

#### How is IELTS Test 2018 scheduled?

On the test day of IELTS 2018 exam, candidates appear for the Listening, Reading and Writing tests one after the other in the same sequence, without any breaks in between the module sets. These components are always taken in the above-mentioned order as given in the IELTS 2018 Test pattern, barring the Speaking module.

According to the IELTS Test pattern 2018, the Speaking module can be scheduled either after break on the same day as the other three tests, or within seven days before or after the registered date of test. However, it is decided by the officials and much depends on the specific IELTS test centre from where the candidate is appearing from. As per the test pattern of IELTS 2018, the speaking test is conducted as a one-on-one test to assess a candidate's holistic proficiency English communication skills. This means candidates are put through a real-life conversation with a real person to get their English conversation skills tested. However, the responses of the test taker are recorded for detailed evaluation. The test results of IELTS depend on the overall performance of the candidate in IELTS 2018.

International English Language Testing System, acronym as IELTS is an English language proficiency test. Hence, the IELTS 2018 Test pattern is structured in a way that it reflects all the related skill sets including Listening, Reading, Writing, and Speaking of the candidate aspiring to either study or work abroad. According to the current statistics, IELTS test scores are accepted by over 10,000 organizations worldwide, including schools, universities, Government departments, employers, immigration authorities and professional bodies.

#### Is there any Eligibility Criteria for appearing in IELTS 2018?

There is no specific IELTS 2018 eligibility criteria set by any of the exam conducting bodies. However, the selection procedure varies among universities/organisations. Hence, the candidate should be aware of the application procedure of the institute/s where he/she applies to. An aspirant has the freedom to choose IELTS test date 2018 in accordance with his/her convenience and availability of seats. The IELTS test is available throughout the year and in 2018, IELTS would be conducted 48 times.

How much does it cost to take the ielts test in India?

IELTS Exam Fee. In India, the registration fee for IELTS exam for all tests administered up to 31st March 2018, the fee is INR 12,100 and for those administered after 1st April 2018, it is INR 12,650.

#### **How to Register for IELTS**

Among the language exams required for admissions to universities abroad, IELTS is the most popular exam among Indian students. It is available in two formats: Academic IELTS and General IELTS. Students are required to take the Academic test, while all other applicants who need IELTS scores for Visa purposes need to take the General test. Here in this article, we will look at IELTS Academic test.

#### **IELTS** registration

IELTS test is available on 48 fixed dates per year (up to four times a month), depending on local demand. The candidates have the liberty of giving the exam on any of the 48 days in as per their convenience.

Online – you need to go on the British Council IELTS registration page and create an online profile. Then you'll be required to pay the exam fee. Online registration on the British Council IELTS India

website is the fastest and easiest method. Through the online method, you can register anytime and on any day. You will be required to pay with a credit/debit card.

In person – You can register in person at British Council office or an IDP India office. You may download the online form or fill in a paper application at the office. You will be required to pay the fee through credit card/debit card, demand draft or ICICI bank deposit slip. You will receive an instant confirmation of your reservation.

#### **IELTS Exam Slot Booking**

For booking a slot for the IELTS exam, the aspirant needs a valid passport and a debit/credit card to pay the registration fee of INR 12650.

Some important points to remember while registering for the IELTS exam:

- The aspirant must be above the age of 16 for taking the IELTS exam.
- The information provided by the aspirant while registering should match the information in the passport.
- The candidates need to carry their passport while going for the test.
- The aspirants need to keep their debit/credit card handy while registering for the IELTS exam.

Doing this should give you plenty of time to retake the exam if you feel the first attempt wasn't great.

#### **Scoring in PTE**

PTE Academic is scored on a scale of 10-90 where 10 is lowest, with increments of 1 point. Graded on the scale, the score showcase the person's ability to read, speak, understand verbal instructions and write the English language. #### **National Test Dates**

National test dates are for the United States, United States territories, and Puerto Rico. If you have missed the late registration deadline for a test date, you may be able to request standby testing.

All requests for accommodations and English Learner supports, including appeals, must be submitted by the late registration deadline through the Test Accessibility and Accommodations (TAA) system. Accommodations and English learner supports are not available for standby testing.



# SAT Exam (Standardized test administered)

AT is a standardized test administered by the College Board and is required to be taken by students seeking admission in undergraduate schools. SAT exam has been developed to evaluate the written, verbal and mathematical skills of the candidates.

Applicants to undergraduate courses, particularly in US and Canada, are required to take the SAT exam. If the student is looking to get admission to a particular course, s/he can take the SAT subject tests to show his knowledge and understanding of that particular subject. Subject tests are offered in areas like Literature, History, Mathematics, Sciences and Foreign Languages.

A recent review of admissions policies by The National Center for Fair & Open Testing (FairTest) revealed that many colleges have moved away from SAT subject test, which some years back was crucial for admission to top American universities.

#### **SAT Pattern**

SAT exam pattern is as follow- three sections, namely, Math, Reading, and Writing. There is an optional section which is called the Essay, which has one 50 minutes long substantial passage from which the student needs to build their argument. Students are not scored on this section. Here we cover the general SAT test pattern.

#### **Scoring in SAT**

The SAT is divided into two sections - 1. Reading, Writing, and 2.Mathematics. These two sections are scored on a 200-800 point scale, for a maximum total score of 1600.

SAT subject test scores are measured on a scale of 200 to 800. There are additional sub scores reported on a 20-80 scale. The scores of a student reflect on how he/she compared with other students who took the test. An average SAT score is around 1000. Anything above 1200 is considered a good SAT score. The maximum anyone can score on SAT is the perfect score of 1600. Since you receive scaled scores, you should have some understanding of SAT scaled scores and percentiles.

#### **SAT Results**

SAT test results are typically released within 4-5 weeks of the test administration and can be viewed online. Students can choose to send their test scores to colleges of their choice. They also have the option to cancel their test score or withhold them from being sent to certain colleges.

#### **SAT Dates**

The SAT is conducted only a few times a year between October to June. You don't have the luxury of selecting an exam date suitable as per your convenience, which is the case with other exams. You need to plan your exam prep according to these test dates. These exams are scheduled to suit your application deadlines for the fall semester.

The TOEFL iBT test measures your ability to use and understand English at the university level. And it evaluates how well you combine your reading, listening, speaking and writing skills to perform academic tasks.

#### Who is eligible for Toefl test?

Ordinarily a pass in 10+2 level of any recognised Indian Board or University is a suitable qualification to take the TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language)test. However, the test is suitable for candidates studying at high school level or higher.

#### How much does it cost to take Toefl test?

The cost to take the TOEFL is US\$170 (or, about 11,265 Indian Rupees). In addition to the cost of taking the TOEFL other charges may apply in certain circumstances: For late registration an additional charge of US\$35 will apply. For rescheduling a charge of US\$60 will apply.

#### What Is the Overall TOEFL Exam Pattern?

The TOEFL iBT is a four-hour, computerized test with four sections: Reading, Listening, Speaking, and Writing. **You'll use one main skill for each section** (so on Reading you'll read passages and on Listening you'll listen to audio clips), with some questions or tasks requiring the use of multiple skills.

All sections are timed. You'll always have 20 minutes on Speaking and 50 minutes on Writing.

However, the Reading and Listening sections vary in length due to unscored, experimental questions. Reading ranges from 60 to 80 minutes long, while Listening ranges from 60 to 90 minutes long.

There will be no indication telling you which questions are experimental and which ones aren't, so don't spend too much time worrying about this—just try your best on all questions!

Finally, you'll have **one 10-minute break** in the middle of the test, between the Listening and Speaking sections. This break is **mandatory**, meaning you **must** take it. You may take other breaks during the test, but you will not be able to pause the timer for these.

#### Where and When Can I Take the TOEFL iBT Test?

The TOEFL test has over 50 test dates per year at authorized test centers around the world. You can retake the test as many times as you wish, but you cannot take it more than once in a 12-day period. If you already have a test appointment, you cannot register for another test date that is within 12 days of your existing appointment.

This retake policy will be enforced even if a violation is not immediately identified (for example, inconsistent registration information).

• If the violation is identified after registration but before the test date, your test appointment will be canceled and your test fee will not be refunded.

If the violation is not identified until after your scores have been reported, your scores will be canceled. You and any score recipients will be notified by a cancellation letter, and your test fee will not be refunded.

#### What Is the Paper-Delivered TOEFL Test Pattern?

We've gone over everything you need to know about the TOEFL exam pattern—but what about the paper-delivered TOEFL?

This version of the TOEFL is only offered in areas where the TOEFL iBT (or "Internet-based test") is unavailable. Most people take the TOEFL iBT, but if you're taking the paper TOEFL, it's important to familiarize yourself with its pattern and see how it differs from the TOEFL iBT.

Here is a brief overview of the paper-TOEFL test pattern:

As you can see, though the two TOEFL versions share many similarities, they're not 100 percent identical. Below are some of the key ways the paper TOEFL differs from the TOEFL iBT:

- It doesn't have a Speaking section: Since you can't record your responses without a computer, there is no feasible way to recreate the Speaking section on the paper test.
- It doesn't have any experimental questions: On the TOEFL iBT, you'll have unscored questions on either the Reading or Listening section, but you won't get any such questions on the paper TOEFL. Thus, all Reading and Listening questions you get on the paper TOEFL will count toward your final score.
- It's a full hour shorter than the TOEFL iBT: Without a Speaking section and experimental questions, the paper TOEFL is about an hour shorter (three hours) than the TOEFL iBT (four hours).
- **Listening comes before Reading:** On the TOEFL iBT, Reading comes first and Listening comes second, but these two sections switch positions on the paper TOEFL.
- It doesn't have a 10-minute break (or any break at all): Because the paper TOEFL is shorter than the TOEFL iBT, there is no mandatory break in the middle of the test. In other words, you must take the entire paper TOEFL in one sitting.

#### What is a good score on the TOEFL?

90-100: TOEFL scores in this range are perfectly good. At this level, your TOEFL score is good enough for most universities. With these TOEFL scores, you also have a shot at getting a position as an RA, TA, or GA on campus. 100-110: These are very good TOEFL scores.

Exhibit design is a collaborative process, integrating the disciplines of architecture, landscape architecture, graphic design, audio-visual engineering, digital media, lighting, interior design and content development to develop an audience experience that interprets information, involves and engages a user and influences their understanding of a subject. Throughout the planning and design process, exhibit designers work closely with graphic designers, content specialists, architects, fabricators, technical specialists, audio-visual experts, and, in the case of museums and other mission-based institutions, stakeholders like community members, government agencies and other partner organizations.



#### **FASHION BUSINESS MANAGEMENT**

As we approach the second generation of globalisation, fashion markets continue to expand exponentially. Evolutions of design methodologies, business ecologies, complex global supply chains, and media innovations have created new career spheres spanning a broad range of specializations. With the substantial advancements that have taken place in regards to the sourcing, supply and production aspects of fashion and the transition of fashion into a global industry, it is appropriate to follow a curriculum that will rigorously develop a diverse student body who ultimately will become industry leaders in the field. Such leaders, when armed with the appropriate tools and knowledge, have the capacity to influence and transform current systems into sustainable future frameworks.



#### **FASHION COMMUNICATION**

Fashion Communication is a new but very exciting field that has opened up in the fashion industry. In today's scene of extremely fast developments in the fashion industry, many Indian brands are competing with international brands. This has opened up tremendous possibilities for a designer of fashion communication, who will work on design strategies, brands, portfolios etc. He / she will also work on areas such as visual merchandising, styling, graphic design, display and exhibit design, advertising, public relations, and creative writing. The students passing out, will have high level skill and domain knowledge, and emerge as professionals who offer the extremely effective communication solutions for the fashion and lifestyle industry.



#### **FASHION DESIGN**

Fashion design is the art of the application of design and aesthetics or natural beauty to clothing and accessories. Fashion design is influenced by cultural and social latitudes, and has varied over time and place. Fashion designers work in a number of ways in designing clothing and accessories; and, because of the time required to bring a garment onto the market, must at times anticipate changing consumer tastes.



#### **FASHION MEDIA COMMUNICATION**

The Fashion Media Communication course emphasises on communicating fashion through media formats such as journalism (print, electronic or new media), events and promotions (public relations and advertising). The industry internship finally readies the budding stylists to take on the world.



#### FILM & VIDEO COMMUNICATION

Film as a medium, is closest to reality, and mirrors every aspect of the human experience. Film-making is telling a story through moving images. India is rich in living traditions and stories, and provides a vast live laboratory for film-makers.



#### **FURNITURE & INTERIOR DESIGN**

Furniture impacts our immediate living environment breathing life and function into empty spaces. Objects around us become extensions of our bodies and directly affect the quality of life. Through sensitive design, furniture can cater to a variety of human needs such as those of the elderly, children, and the differently abled.



#### **GRAPHIC DESIGN**

The Graphic Communication course is structured to encourage students to demonstrate initiative and curiosity in the world around them. Further students are exposed to explore and experiment, challenge and create, discover and debate. This Course module enables individual perspectives, and the ability to draw on own experiences. The programme structure helps students to develop skills in listening, negotiating, research, thinking creatively, idea generation, manipulating visual languages and techniques.

Students are also encouraged to cultivate and share ideas, as well as develop their own philosophy and unique way of working.



#### **INDUSTRIAL DESIGN**

#### INTERIOR ACHITECTURE DESIGN

Interior architecture is the design of a space which has been created by structural boundaries and the human interaction within these boundaries. It can also be the initial design and plan for use, the later redesign to accommodate a changed purpose, or a significantly revised design for adaptive reuse of the building shell.

The latter is often part of sustainable architecture practices, conserving resources through "recycling" a structure by adaptive redesign. Generally referred to as the spatial art of environmental design, form and practice, interior architecture is the process through which the interiors of buildings are designed, concerned with all aspects of the human uses of structural spaces.



#### INTERIOR SPACE & EQUIPMENT DESIGN

Interior Space and Furniture Design discipline focuses on designing and planning of interior spaces for all kinds of human needs. The learners concentrate on designing spaces - interior and exterior - according to their functional hierarchies and interrelationships. Spaces to be more functional and aesthetic require components like furniture, seating, storage, lighting etc., so only Interior Design alone is not sufficient.

The interior space design should be integrated with furniture & accessories, and both should have an harmonious interaction .This makes the built space respond like an efficient, well designed system. This approach imparts the learner a unique edge than merely "interior decoration". Of the many Interior Space and Furniture Design Courses the one at MIT ID emphasizes on the holistic learning.



#### JEWELLERY DESIGN

The course intervenes to hone and develop specific context and individual expression in each graduate against their own learning blocks. #### **KNITWEAR DESIGN**

The programme offered by the Department of Fashion & Apparel emphasises on the integration of design concepts in leather apparel and products with material knowledge to respond to the requirements of specific target markets. Exposure to the industry through field trips, tannery training and industry internship is an important part of the curriculum.

The multidisciplinary approach including inputs ranging from market research, material and technical knowledge for product development develops an ability in students to handle different materials for different product types in leather.



#### **LIFESTYLE & ACCESSORY DESIGN**

Expeditious globalization has given impulsive charismatic trends, the vibrancy and variety in jewellery market has given rise to the style quotient of fashionistas. We focus on enlightenment of global cultures and life styles, which will nourish them with innovative aspirations with blending of cultures and lifestyle into contemporary designs. To enjoy the success in this industry, one needs to be full of intense flow of creative skills and innovative thoughts. Opportunities are endless from small boutiques to large lifestyle houses and accessories designers.



#### **PHOTOGRAPHY**

Photography is the art, science, and practice of creating durable images by recording light or other electromagnetic radiation, either chemically by means of a light-sensitive material such as photographic film, or electronically by means of an image sensor. Typically, a lens is used to focus the light reflected or emitted from objects into a real image on the light-sensitive surface inside a camera during a timed exposure. The result in an electronic image sensor is an electrical charge at each pixel, which is electronically processed and stored in a digital image file for subsequent display or processing.



#### PRODUCT & INTERFACE DESIGN

Product & Interface Design is a three year specialization that deals with the physical world around us, and with the elements that make that physical world. No product exists in a vacuum, and is made by someone, bought by someone, used by someone and discarded, sometimes reused by someone. A key component of product design is understanding this cycle and more importantly, understanding the user. We encourage students to engage with the real world by asking questions, identifying and solving design problems and empathizing with people who use or need design.



#### **PRODUCT DESIGN**

Product design is the process of creating a new product to be sold by a business to its customers. A very broad concept, it is essentially the efficient and effective generation and development of ideas through a process that leads to new products. In a systematic approach, product designers conceptualize and evaluate ideas, turning them into tangible inventions and products. The product designer's role is to combine art, science, and technology to create new products that other people can use. Their evolving role has been facilitated by digital tools that now allow designers to communicate, visualize, analyse and actually produce tangible ideas in a way that would have taken greater manpower in the past.



#### **TEXTILE DESIGN**

**Textile design** is the process of creating designs and structures for knitted, woven, non-woven or embellishments of fabrics.

Textile designing involves producing patterns for cloth used in clothing, household textiles (such as towels) and decorative textiles such as carpets. The field encompasses the actual pattern making as well as supervising part or all of the production process. In other words, textile design is a process from the raw material into finished product. Fibre, yarn and finishes are the key elements to be considered during the textile design procedure.



#### TRANSPORTATION DESIGN

Automotive design is the profession involved in the development of the appearance, and to some extent the ergonomics, of motor vehicles or more specifically road vehicles. This most commonly refers to automobiles but also refers to motorcycles, trucks, buses, coaches, and vans. The functional design and development of a modern motor vehicle is typically done by a large team from many different disciplines included within automotive engineering. Automotive design in this context is primarily concerned with developing the visual appearance or aesthetics of the vehicle, though it is also involved in the creation of the product concept. Automotive design is practiced by designers who usually have an art background and a degree in industrial design or transportation design.



#### **USER EXPERIENCE DESIGN**

User experience design (UX or UXD or UED) fully encompasses traditional human-computer interaction (HCI) design, and extends it by addressing all aspects of a product or service as perceived by users.[1]User experience is any aspect of a person's interaction with a given IT system, including the interface, graphics, industrial design, physical interaction, and the manual.



#### **VIDEO GAME DESIGN**

Game design is the game development process of designing the content and rules of a game in the pre-production stage and design of gameplay, environment, storyline, and characters during production stage. The designer of a game is very much like the director of a film; the designer is the visionary of the game and controls the artistic and technical elements of the game in fulfilment of their vision. Game design requires artistic and technical competence as well as writing skills.



#### **VISUAL ART**

The visual arts are art forms that create works that are primarily visual in nature, such as ceramics, drawing, painting, sculpture, printmaking, design, crafts, photography, video, filmmaking and architecture. These definitions should not be taken too strictly as many artistic disciplines (performing arts, conceptual art, textile arts) involve aspects of the visual arts as well as arts of other types. Also included within the visual artsare the applied arts[2] such as industrial design, graphic design, fashion design, interior design and decorative art.



#### **VISUAL COMMUNICATION**

Visual communication is communication through visual aid and is described as the conveyance of ideas and information in forms that can be read or looked upon. Visual communication in part or whole relies on vision, and is primarily presented or expressed with two dimensional images, it includes: signs, typography, drawing, graphic design, illustration, Industrial Design, Advertising, Animation colour and electronic resources. It also explores the idea that a visual message accompanying text has a greater power to inform, educate, or persuade a person or audience.
